Huairou Commission is a global movement of grassroots women's organisations leading a transformative agenda for inclusive resilience and gender justice. Huairou represents nearly one million women from rural, urban, and indigenous communities. Our member groups are networks, cooperatives, federations of self-help groups, and women-led community-based organisations, all working on diverse, locally appropriate solutions driven by a common vision centred on the empowerment and leadership of women from under-resourced communities.
